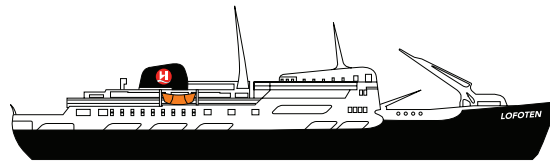


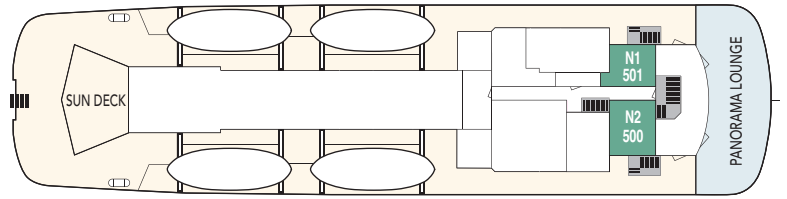
MS LOFOTEN

MS Lofoten, our old time favourite, was launched in Oslo in 1964, and provides a voyage of real nostalgia and an intimate informal atmosphere. The ship is named after the Lofoten Islands located just north of the Arctic Circle and are famous for their dramatic scenery, often described as "a natural masterpiece". MS Lofoten is the second ship in Hurtigruten carrying this name. She was refurbished and refitted in 1964, but the original style and atmosphere is still preserved. With comfortable lounges and panorama decks this "old lady" is simply incomparable. The cabins on board are relatively plain, but very cosy.

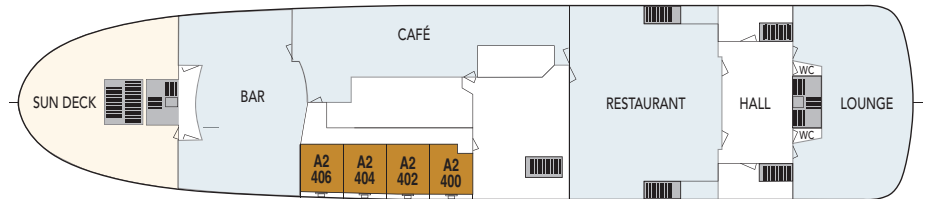

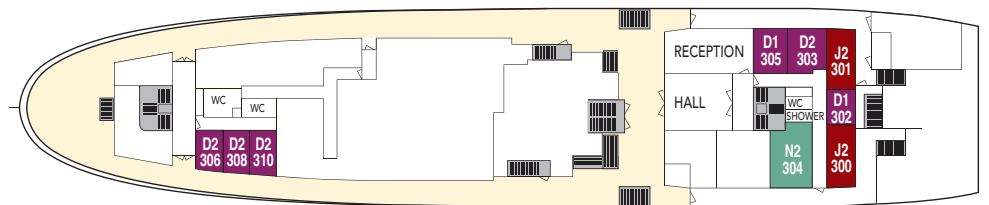

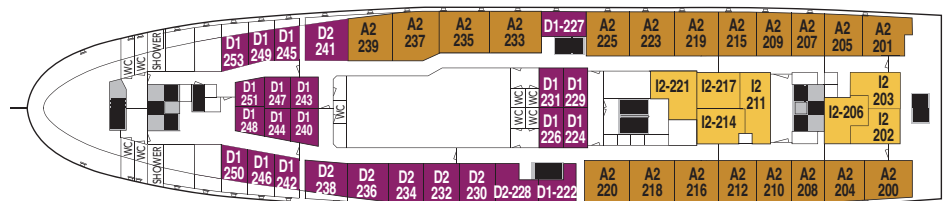
Saloon deck



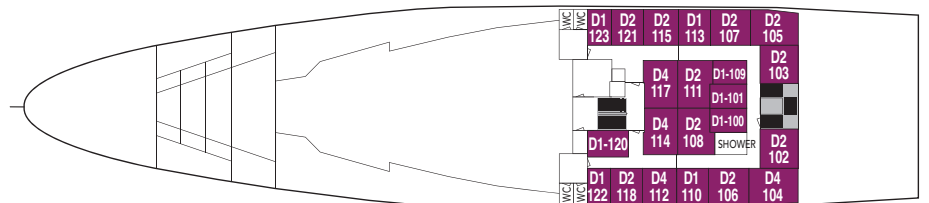
