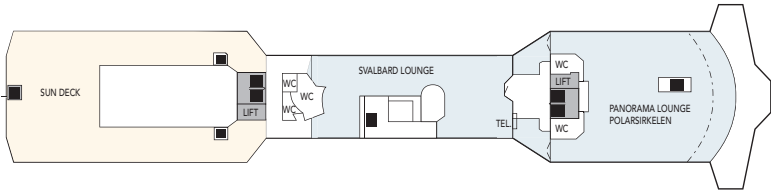
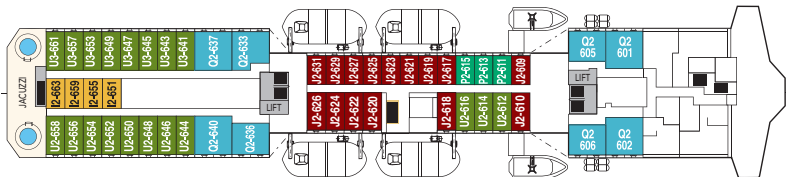


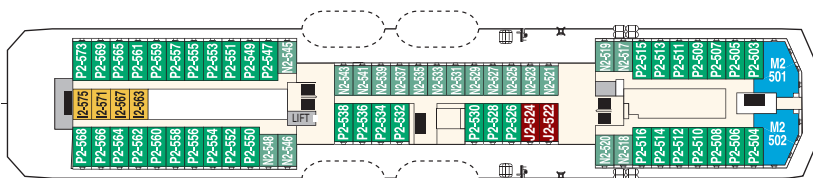
MS NORDKAPP



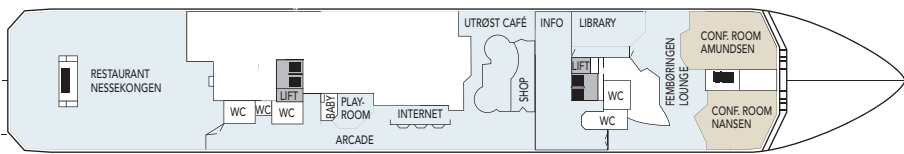
Deck 7 MS Nordkapp is named after one of the highlights of the Hurtigruten voyage, the majestic North Cape, a rock formation situated at 71 degrees North. It has attracted explorers since it was named by Richard Chancellor who was passing the cape in 1553 while searching for the Northeast Passage. The ship was built in 1996 and on board you are surrounded by artworks from the renowned Norwegian artist, Karl Erik Harr. MS Nordkapp is part of the ship class built in the 1990s, and has been upgraded with junior suites and Jacuzzis.



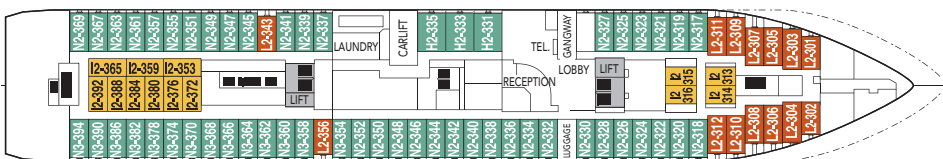
Deck 6 The godmother of MS Nordkapp was the queen of Norway, Queen Sonja.



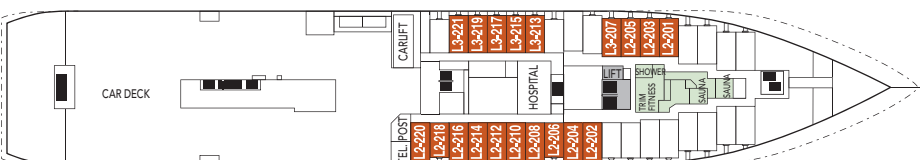
